### Hotel to Campus Directions

#### Quality Inn & Suites Bandera Pointe or Motel 6

**To Brandeis:** Right on Loop 1604 West. U-Turn at Braun Road. Exit Hausman/Kyle Seale Parkway. Right on Skyhawk Drive. (Just over 3 miles total.)

**To Marshall:** Right on Loop 1604 West. U-Turn at Braun Road. Exit Bandera Road. Right on Bandera. Left on Eckert. Right on Lobo Lane. (Just over 7 miles total.)

**To Stevens:** Right on Loop 1604 West. Exit Potranco Road. Left on Potranco. Campus on Potranco on left. (Just over 9 miles total.)

**To Taft:** Right on Loop 1604 West. Exit Culebra Road/FM 471. Turn right. Campus 1 mile up on right. (About 5.5 miles total.)

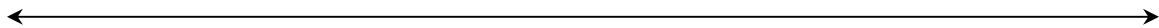
#### Intown Suites Leon Valley North or Leon Valley South

**To Brandeis:** Right on Bandera Road. Right on Loop 1604 East Feeder. Right on Skyhawk Drive, just after you pass Farris Stadium, before you get to light. (About 6.5 miles total.)

**To Marshall:** Right on Bandera. Right on Eckert. Right on Lobo Lane. (About 2 miles total.)

**To Stevens:** Take Bandera Road (Tx-16) South to Loop 410. Turn right on Loop 410 West. Exit Sea World/Tx 151. Right on 151. Exit Potranco Road. Left on Potranco. Stevens will be on right on Potranco @ Ellison Road. (Just over 8 miles total.)

**To Taft:** Right on Bandera Road. Left on Grissom Road. Continue on Grissom to Culebra Road (Grissom turns in to Culebra, just keep going straight.). Continue on Culebra past Loop 1604. Campus will 1 mile outside 1604 on your left. (About 7.5 miles total.)

### Campus to Campus Directions

#### Taft to Stevens

From Taft, turn right on FM 471/Culebra Road. Bear Right on Loop 1604 West. Stay on 1604 West to Potranco Road. Turn Left on Potranco. Steven High School will on your left. Enter campus at the Dugas Street entrance.

#### Stevens to Taft

From Stevens, turn right on Potranco Road. Turn right on Loop 1604 North. Exit Loop 1604 at the FM 471 West/Culebra Exit. Turn left onto FM 471/Culebra Road. Taft High School will be on your left. Enter campus at the light.

#### Brandeis to Marshall

From Skyhawk Drive, turn right onto the 1604 North feeder. Get over to your left as quick as possible. At the light, take the loop under the freeway. Stay on the feeder road. You will now be heading west. The next light is Bandera Road. Turn left at Bandera Road and continue on Bandera approximately 3 miles to Eckert Road. Turn Left onto Eckert. Marshall High School will be on your right on Eckert Road. Enter the campus on Lobo Lane.

#### Marshall to Brandeis

Turn left onto Eckert Road from the campus. Follow Eckert to Bandera. Turn right on Bandera Road. Follow Bandera approximately 3 miles to Loop 1604. Turn right on Loop 1604 East. Stay on the feeder road. Just after you pass Farris Stadium, turn right on Skyhawk Drive. Skyhawk will dead end at Bamberger Road. Turn left on Bamberger and enter the campus at the first entrance on your left.

### Host Campus Parking Information

#### **Brandeis**

From Skyhawk Drive, turn left onto Bamberger. Take first left, which is a rear entrance near the soccer field. Parking is available further down the road on the left.

#### **Marshall**

Enter the campus from Eckert by turning on to Lobo Lane. The soccer field will be immediately on your right (on the corner of Eckert and Lobo Lane). Plenty of parking is available near the fields.

#### **Stevens**

Enter the campus from the Dugas Road Entrance (just past Ellison off Potranco). Follow Dugas around to the athletic fields and park near fields.

#### **Taft**

Enter campus at the light on FM 471 (Culebra Road). After entering campus, go to the left, towards Communications Arts High School. There is a small road that runs behind Communications Arts to the athletic fields. Plenty of parking is available behind Communications Arts, near the portable classrooms.
